

The Freeway blades are single use sterile blades, which have been manufactured from quality biodegradable plastics that are also suitable for incineration after use in accordance with local hospital policy.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Before use, the Freeway blades should be applied to a suitable handle made to the ISO 7376 fibre optic fitting.

- 1) Peel open the sterile pouch to expose the rear block of the blade.
- 2) Holding the tip of the blade in one hand and the handle in the other, hook the hook fitting of the block on to the handle. The blade should be angled at about 15° from the handle to ensure easier

fitting.

makes a right angle with the handle. As the rear of the block locks into place, the light should come on.

The use of force should not be necessary to mount a blade correctly on a handle.

As a precaution, the blades should be fully applied and tested on the handle before being used on a patient. Always have spare blades and handles available in case of emergency or unforeseen failure.

For ease of identification for compatibility with ISO 7376 'Green fitting' handles, Freeway laryngoscope blades are colour coded with a green plastic circle under the blocks.
